



Alan Bruce Cressler

November 7, 1951 - December 19, 2017

Alan Bruce Cressler, age 66, of Helvetia, died Tuesday, December 19, 2017. He was born on November 7, 1951, in Jacksonville, FL, a son of the late Josephine Isabelle Leslie Cressler and Morgan Cressler, who survives in Melrose, FL. In addition to his father, he is also survived by one sister Susan Okun of Melrose; one brother David Cressler of Atlantic Beach, FL; and three nephews: David Cressler, Jr. and Ben Cressler, both of Atlantic Beach, and Zach Okun of Granada, Nicaragua.

Having spent six years as a news journalist, editor, and photographer during the 1970s, Bruce then pursued a career that spanned over twenty years in service, product development, marketing, and sales of pathology laboratory equipment and various other biomedical instrumentation and software, travelling extensively throughout the U.S., Canada, and the United Kingdom, to a lesser extent. He later retired after eight years as the Director of the Helvetia Public Library, and enjoyed Amateur Radio from a 2500 ft. hilltop at his peaceful Helvetia home.

The body was cremated.
