November 20, 1921 - July 5, 2018

Beatrice Lee Ware, affectionately nicknamed “Old Timer” by her husband, age 96, of League City, Texas, and formerly of French Creek, died Thursday, July 5, 2018, at the Regency Care Center in League City. She was born November 20, 1921, at Grand Camp, WV, a daughter of the late Abraham Lincoln “Abe” and Lula “Lou” Loudin Burr. 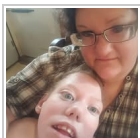
