January 21, 1923 - April 28, 2016

Berkeley A. Harrison, age 93, of Buckhannon, died Thursday, April 28, 2016, at his home. He was born in Webster County on January 21, 1923, a son of the late Perry B. and Arlie Shaver Harrison. He was united in marriage on March 3, 1945, to Anna Jean Cochran Harrison, who preceded him in death on May 25, 2014. In addition to his wife and parents he was preceded in death by four sisters and three brothers.

He is survived by two daughters: Judy and husband Vincin Foster of Buckhannon, WV and Patricia and husband William Burton of Columbus, OH; three sons: Dan and wife Elizabeth Harrison of Westerville, OH, Roger and wife Karen Harrison of Irvine, KY, and Dale and wife Theresa Harrison of Richmond, KY; twelve grandchildren, twenty-one great grandchildren and four great great grandchildren; two brothers: Laco Harrison of Buckhannon and Calvin and wife Brenda Harrison of Volga; one sister, Edna Strader of Elkins and several nieces and nephews survive.

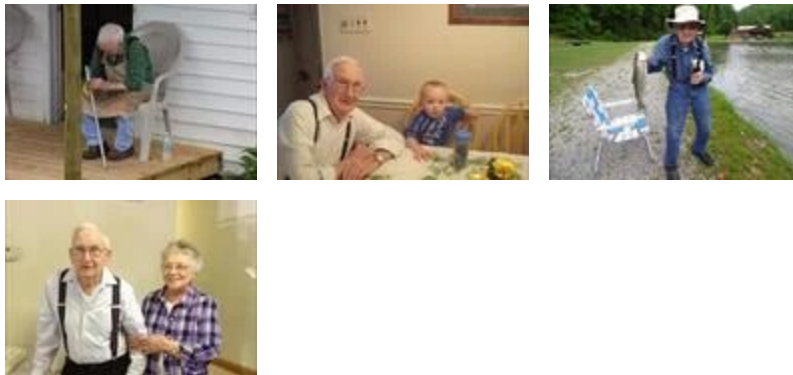
