Charlotte A. Henline, age 69, of French Creek, WV, died Wednesday, October 14, 2015, at the United Hospital Center in Bridgeport, WV. She was born July 10, 1946, in Rochester, NY, a daughter of the late Richard and Rita Virginia McGrath Graney. She was united in marriage on August 23, 1964, to George D. Henline, who survives. In addition to her husband she is survived by three sons: Edward and wife Susie Henline of Buckhannon, WV, Timothy and wife Meriah Henline of French Creek, WV and Richard and wife Melinda Henline of Charleston, WV; nine grandchildren, Chantelle, William, Daniel, Emily, McKinley, Zander, Ansley, Layna and Caden; two great grandchildren, Carleigh and Xavier. She was on the original Board of the Stockert Youth Center, served on the Board of Directors for Womens Aid in Crisis and was on the WV State AIDS Council. She was a member of the WV Horseman's Association and the Upshur County Democratic Committee. She was a WV Susan B. Anthony Award Winner. Charlotte volunteered to numerous organizations. She was retired from the WV Agency on Aging where she was an Outreach Coordinator. Our families were joined at the hip for a couple of decades, so all of you are very much part of the Clowdus family fabric, and we shared many lovely--and funny--memories. 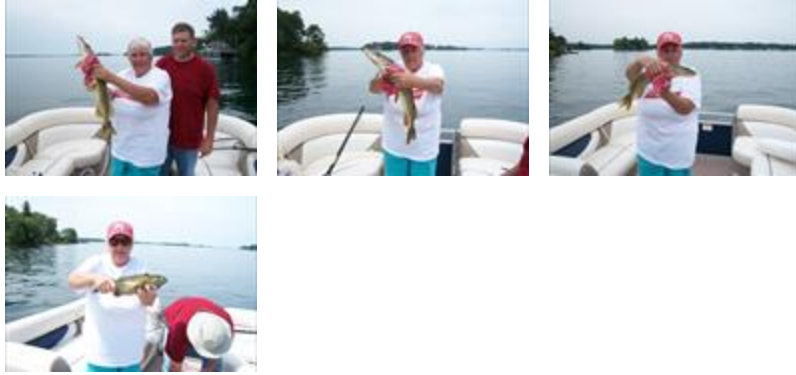
