Donis J. Cutright, age 82, of Buckhannon, the Ivy Community, died Saturday, June 9, 2012, at the United Hospital Center in Bridgeport. He was born January 7, 1930, in Jerryville, Webster County, WV, a son of the late Charles Brannon and Effie Ruth Cogar Cutright. On March 29, 1956, he was united in marriage to Rowena F. Manley Cutright who preceded him in death on April 29, 2011. Surviving are two sons: Keith and wife Lydia Cutright of Buckhannon and Brent and wife Debbie Cutright of Buckhannon; three grandsons: Corey Cutright, Codey Cutright, and Nicholas T.
