



## Eddie E. Veith

March 22, 1939 - April 10, 2019

Eddie E. Veith, age 80, of Carol Street, Buckhannon, died April 10, 2019, at his home. He was born on March 22, 1939, in Lumberport, WV, a son of the late Fred E. and Lilly V. Lindsey Veith. On August 19, 1978, he was united in marriage to Sally Anne Sheridan Veith, who survives. 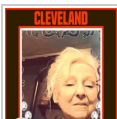

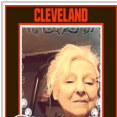

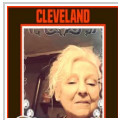
