



Elmer "Brooks" Haymond

March 23, 1942 - January 8, 2024

Elmer "Brooks" Haymond, age 81, of Buckhannon, died peacefully at his home on Monday, January 8, 2024, following an extended illness. He was born on March 23, 1942, in Ingo, WV, a son of the late William Ford Haymond and Lottie Isenhardt Haymond. He is survived by his wife of 58 years, Norma Powers Haymond.
