

Hayward D. "Has" Lewis

March 15, 1929 - March 25, 2021

Hayward D. "Has" Lewis, age 92, of the Bailey Ridge community, died Thursday, March 25, 2021, at his home. He was born on March 15, 1929, at Cutright Chapel, WV, a son of the late Joseph Edward and Nola Cutright Lewis. On March 14, 1951, he was united in marriage to Retha Avanella Barbara Marcella Manley Lewis, who preceded him in death on April 13, 2010. In addition to his parents and wife, he was also preceded in death by one sister Irene Wagoner and three brothers: Stan, Ped, and Don Lewis. He is survived by two sons: Gail Lewis and Lenny Lewis and wife Robin, both of Bailey Ridge; two daughters: Kay and husband Steven L. 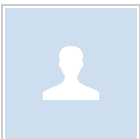
