



## Hildred Gay Marsh

November 12, 1922 - April 14, 2018

Hildred Gay Marsh, age 95, of the McCartney Road, Buckhannon, died Saturday, April 14, 2018, at her home. 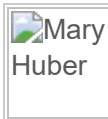
