



James Darrell Loudin

March 8, 1933 - September 9, 2012

James Darrell Loudin, age 79, a 20-month resident of Paula's Care Home, and former resident of Rock Cave, died Sunday, September 9, 2012. He was born March 8, 1933, a son of the late Carlos O. and Ona Roxanna Potts Loudin. On June 14, 1981, he was united in marriage to Bea Jones White, who survives. He had also been a member of the Aletha Chapter 82 Order of the Eastern Star since 1984. He served on the Adrian Public Service Water Board for 16 years and the Rock Cave Cemetery Board of Trustees. He had been a member of the Banks District Volunteer Fire Department since 1975. He was retired from Columbia Gas after 31 years of service.
