



Lennie Floyd Tenney

April 29, 1945 - February 17, 2026

Lennie Floyd Tenney, age 80, of Buckhannon, died peacefully at his home surrounded by his family on Tuesday, February 17, 2026. He was born on April 29, 1945, in Ellamore, a son of the late Charles and Vera Lamb Tenney. His mother passed away when he was eight years old and his father later remarried June Helmick. He had one half brother David (Christina) Tenney from this marriage and then later his father married Rosemary Scott and he had three half-brothers: John Tenney (Flo), Randy Tenney (Angela), Chris Tenney (Lisa); and two half-sisters: Diana Gregory (Jim) and Mary Hawkins (Randy).

years before they closed and then he worked for Trus Joist for fifteen years until his retirement. He was always a hardworking, loving husband, father, brother, and friend. At times some may have thought he was a grizzly bear, but those that knew him best know he was actually a teddy bear. He knew and loved the Lord and was a long-time member, teacher, and trustee of the Tallmansville Baptist Church.
