Linda Kay Snyder, age 77, of the Lick Run community, Buckhannon, died Friday, September 19, 2025, at Holbrook Healthcare Center in Buckhannon. She was born on July 10, 1948, at Buckhannon, a daughter of the late Asa Orton Sayre and Evelyn Marie Gillispie Sayre Wilson. On October 17, 1969, she was united in marriage to Gerald N. Snyder, who survives. Also surviving are one son Jamie R.
