Marlin R. Loudin, age 79, of Adrian, died Friday, May 11, 2018, at his home, surrounded by his loving family. He was born on November 1, 1938, in Upshur County, a son of the late Bernice and Garnet Smith Loudin. On September 20, 1959, he was united in marriage to Idella Hyre Loudin, who survives. 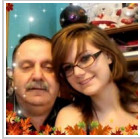

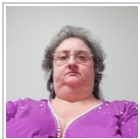
