November 20, 1917 - November 21, 2016

Martha Ellen Hamner Daniel, age 99, of Buckhannon, went to be with her Lord and Savior on Monday, November 21, 2016, at 8:30 PM, at the Camden-Clark Medical Center in Parkersburg. She was born on November 20, 1917, at Gaines, WV, a daughter of the late Lloyd and Cosbie Strader Hamner. On July 20, 1942, she was united in marriage to Malvin C. “Dan” Daniel, who preceded her in death in 1998. In addition to her parents and husband, she was also preceded in death by three sisters: Bertha Waugh, Ruth Long, and Geneva Arnold and three brothers: Henry, Max, and French Hamner. She is survived by one daughter Patricia “Patsy” Daniel Dillon and husband John of Staunton, VA; two sons: Dan Daniel and wife Becky and David Daniel and wife Brenda, both of Parkersburg; two granddaughters: Chris Conyers and Jennifer Daniel Aument; five grandsons: Mike Dillon, and Jon, Andy, Tim, and Nathan Daniel; thirteen great grandchildren; one sister Juanita Hamner Post of Tennerton; and several nieces and nephews.

Martha was a loving wife, mother, and homemaker who enjoyed many crafts including sewing, quilting, ceramics, and painting. She was a devoted Christian and a longtime member of the Chapel Hill United Methodist Church. 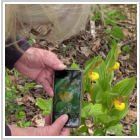
