Patsy R. (Wamsley) Hite, age 71, of Hodgesville, passed away on Tuesday, March 14, 2023, at her home with her loving husband beside her. She was born on December 15, 1951, to the late Robert W. and Naomi Wamsley, who survives.

During her childhood, Patsy lived in Valley Bend, WV, attending the Homestead School and graduated Tygart Valley High School in 1969. She graduated from the WV Beauty Academy in 1970. On December 16, 1971, Patsy married her high school sweetheart and the love of her life, Chris Hite. They welcomed two daughters, Anissa and Tracy to their loving family. As an active and caring mother, Patsy volunteered with her daughters' activities by being a Girl Scout leader, part of their sports booster programs, and being the biggest supporter of them. Patsy was a member of the Order of the Eastern Star and the Upshur County Shrine Club Auxiliary. Patsy was a Methodist by faith. Patsy's creativity shown through her gardening, landscaping, and woodworking. Her spirit was reflected in her beautiful smile, her quick laugh, and her kind words. Patsy's strength was shown every day of her life. Before children, she was a beautician. After the girls were older, Patsy worked at Aladdin Foods at Wesleyan College for ten years and retired from WVU St. Joseph's Hospital after eleven years of service.
