June 1, 1935 - February 11, 2019

Robert L. Bean, age 83, of Buckhannon, a faithful man of God, was called home to be with his Lord and Savior on Monday, February 11, 2019, while a patient at the WV Veterans Nursing Home in Clarksburg. He was born on June 1, 1935, in Alton, WV, a son of the late Marcellus and Florence Genevieve Cain Bean. On February 12, 1969, he was united in marriage to his wife of 50 years, Denise Brenda Clark Bean, who survives. Also surviving are one son Timothy Bean and wife Sandra of Buckhannon and a foster sister Linda and husband Robert Straub of Ohio. He was the last surviving member of his immediate family.
