Robert Lee Rogers, 69, of Buckhannon, departed this life on Sunday, May 24, 2009 at his home after a long illness. He was born October 2, 1939 in Weston, WV, the son of the late Charles and Mary Mildred Rogers. He is survived by his beloved wife, Rev. Barbara J. Rogers, whom he married June 24, 1977, four siblings, seven children, and innumerable other family and friends.
