November 9, 1983 - May 17, 2021

Robert Warren "Robby" Sargent, age 37, of French Creek, died Monday, May 17, 2021, at his home. He was born on November 9, 1983, in Millville, New Jersey, a son of the late Sandra Jane Neaves. He is survived by his grandparents with whom he resided, Warren and Betty Sargent; one "sisser" Dawn Marie Sargent of Fairmont; a best friend Mikey Tenney; and several aunts, uncles, and other family members who loved him very much.

Robby had previously been employed as a dispatcher for the New Jersey Turnpike, and was a member of the POMC, the Upshur County Democrat Executive Committee, LGBT, and the IFPTE Local 194. He attended the Chapel Hill United Methodist Church and the Point Pleasant Chapel.

The family will receive friends on Saturday, May 22, 2021, from 10-11:00 AM, at the Heavner & Cutright Funeral Chapel. A memorial service will begin at 11:00 AM, with the Rev. 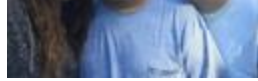

One of my favorite meets was when he called out sick from work to attend the Bennington, VT meet and hid behind a “SEND HELP” sign for the group photo so that no one from his work would find out, lol. The meet where he was able to get us inside the NJTP dispatch was really cool, too.

But we hung out outside of meets, too! I spent a lot of time with Robby in Gloucester City and of course at Indian Acres Campground - Glen 1 Lot 7 - “what happens at the acres stays at the acres!” We (my husband Mike and I) are from the Baltimore, MD area and since the acres was in Cecil County we went there a lot. 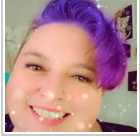

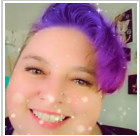
Thank you Judy! I had them play Yellow Submarine at his service. He is with Mom, I just wish he was still with me too.

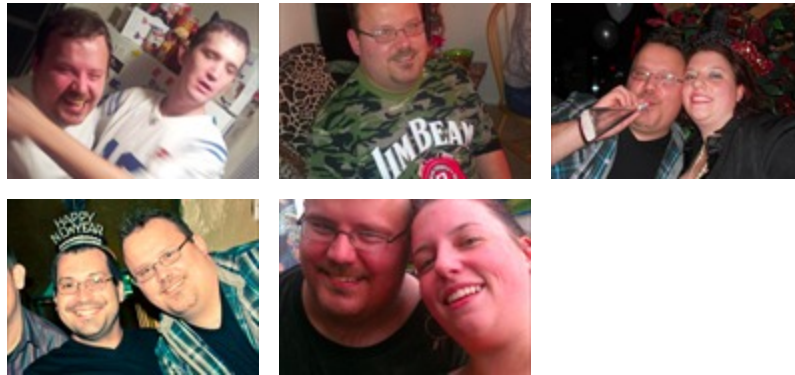
