Samuel Woodford Aylestock, age 96, of Reger Street, Buckhannon, died Friday, July 1, 2016, at Holbrook Nursing Home in Buckhannon. He was born on May 10, 1920, in Sago, WV, a son of the late Parley Samuel and Nola Gould Aylestock. On July 31, 1961, he was united in marriage to Nina Estella Wolfe Aylestock who survives.
